- 8–11 years: Aged 8–11 years (Born in 2015–2018).

12. TRACK

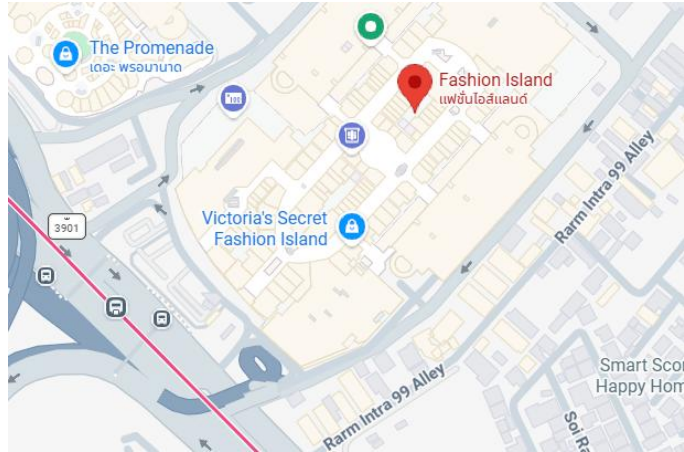
- Under 2 years: 150 - 200 meters
- 2 years and above: 250 - 350 meters

Item	Minimum Standard	Remarks
Overall track width	≥ 5 meters	For safety and fair racing
Start area width	≥ 8 meters	To prevent congestion at the start
Length of first straight	≥ 30 meters	Allows riders to accelerate and prepare for the first turn
Finish area width	≥ 10 meters	Accommodates 8 riders
Turn width	≥ 10 meters	Supports overtaking and safety
Length of finish straight	≥ 20 meters	Space for deceleration after finish
Safety clearance beside track	≥ 2 meters	Prevents collisions with obstacles
Track boundary/safety zone	≥ 1 meter	No spectators allowed inside

- The BMX gate drop sound will be used in all categories.
